S T E M Science \cdot Technology \cdot Engineering \cdot Math

We had a wonderful week in STEM! This week we started a new rotation that will take us through February 14th. During this rotation 4th graders are building chain reaction machines. Third grade students are exploring with Lego We Do 2.0 and learning how to program and drive Sphero robots. 2nd graders are learning about how water moves from high areas to low areas and that movement causes erosion. First grade students are coding and exploring with Code and Go Mouse robots and Botley robots. Kindergarteners are continuing work in their
