We had a wonderful week in STEM! We started a new rotation that will take us through March 5th. During this rotation 4th graders are building and programming VEX robots to complete a dirty, dangerous, or repetitive job. Third graders are designing, building, and programming Lego recycling trucks. Second grade students are learning about and experimenting with erosion as well as designing and testing erosion control solutions. 1st graders are learning about the life cycle of a frog by building models of the stages of their life cycle with our VEX Go kits.



We began reading books from our upcoming visiting author, Troy Cummings! I Found a Kitty! was the book we read together! We watched a video of Troy illustrating a character from his books as well. The kids just loved the books! In kindergarten and second grade, the students created their own paper plate kitty to hang in the library! First graders presented their musical, Mr. Roger's Neighborhood! They were adorable and sang thier hearts out! Our third graders checked books out and continued to work on their third grade musical, "Economan"! They
